

About Sunnyside Lodge

Mission Statement

Sunnyside Lodge Home of the Frail Aged strives; to be recognized by the community and medical profession as leaders in providing quality care for the frail and enhancing their quality of life with dignity and security within a culture characterized by integrity, commitment, compassion and respect for the individual.

How does the Organisation do its work?

Sunnyside Lodge meets its mission by meeting the demand of frailty in the community with commitment and compassion through family support, accommodation and continuous nursing care.

History of the Frail Aged Home

Sunnyside Lodge has been rendering a service to the elderly for the past 50 years since establishment in 1959. What initially started as simply a service which provided accommodation to the elderly, progressed to offering nursing care so that they could carry on the mission of providing compassionate care to ageing citizens.

Over the years, further developments extended our scope of service delivery to also include frail care to the elderly, care to all mentally and physically frail, as well as the terminally ill, including HIV/AIDS final stage patients.

We work in partnership various NGOs as well as the government in caring for residents and families in need.

Currently, we care for 70 aged, frail and terminally ill residents with an average age of 90. In addition to this we offer assisted living to 11 other residents.

How is the Home funded?

Sunnyside lodge is supported by contributions from individuals and corporations, bequests, grants from foundations, gifts from associations, board & lodge fees, government subsidy, and through fundraising.

We are affiliated to the Seventh -day Adventist Church, Meals on Wheels Western Cape (MOWWC) and a qualified member of the South Africa Homes for the Aged (SAHA). We are listed under the Non Profit Organisations of South Africa:

Donations to the home are tax deductible to the extent permitted by law. All donations are used to foster the home's concept of frail care. By becoming part of the Sunnyside family, donors help to increase access of this special kind of caring that is simply not available anywhere else.

S ubsidy
